TRANSPORTATION POLICY

Pre-School: Our District provides free transportation to all preschool students.

Kindergarten and Elementary School: Our District provides free transportation for any student whose residence is **½ mile or more** from the Elementary School OR whose residence requires the student to walk along routes designated as hazardous by the Clayton Board of Education. Students who are not eligible for transportation are considered walkers and parents are responsible for their commute to/from school.

Middle School and High School: Our District provides free transportation for any student whose residence is **OVER 2.5 miles** from the Middle School and High School locations OR whose residence requires the student to walk along routes designated as hazardous by the Clayton Board of Education. Students who are not eligible for transportation are considered walkers and parents are responsible for their commute to/from school.
