

State of NJ Pension Information

Upon employment, we will register eligible employees into one of the following pension programs.

Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund (TPAF)

Certificated Teachers & Administrators

Public Employees Retirement System (PERS)

Staff working more than 32 hours a week, earning \$5,000 or more annually.

Defined Contribution Retirement Program (DCRP)

Employees working less than 32 hours, earning \$5,000 or more annually.

If you are already a member of either TPAF or PERS, our payroll Department will process the necessary transfer on your behalf.

Once registered into TPAF or PERS, you should sign up for online account access – Members Benefits Online System – MBOS. This will provide information regarding years of service, retirement and pension loans.
