## **TRANSPORTATION POLICY**

**PRESCHOOL:** Our District provides free transportation for all preschool students.

**ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**: Our District provides free transportation for any student in Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade whose residence is ½ mile or more from the Elementary School OR whose residence requires the student to walk along routes designated as hazardous by the Clayton Board of Education. Students who are not eligible for transportation are considered walkers and parents are responsible for their commute to/from school.

**MIDDLE SCHOOL and HIGH SCHOOL:** Our District provides free transportation for any student in 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade whose residence is over 2.5 miles from the Middle School and High School locations OR whose residence requires the student to walk along routes designated as hazardous by the Clayton Board of Education. Students who are not eligible for transportation are considered walkers and parents are responsible for their commute to/from school.

## **BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS**

**KIDS CHOICE** offers before and after school childcare for Preschool and Elementary School students. Their program is located at Herma S. Simmons Elementary School in Clayton.
