

Immunization Requirements

Under NJ State law, NJAC 8:57-4, all students attending public or private schools are mandated to be immunized. If there is a communicable disease outbreak and your child is not fully immunized, you may be asked to keep your child home to protect the health and welfare of all students and staff within the school.

Students with a valid "Medical Exemption" written by a Healthcare Provider must have these documents on file in the school's health office. If you do not wish to immunize your child, you may opt to sign a "Religious Exemption." Ask your School Nurse for the form.

If your child turns 11 years old after school starts, he/she has two weeks to complete the mandated shots. Do not delay, have your child vaccinated today! See the list of available locations below where you can have your child immunized.

Sixth (11-year-old shots required to enter 6th grade):

| • | Tdap | 1 dose | given after 11 th birthday |

| • | Meningococcal | 1 dose | given after 11 th birthday |

Vaccination Options & Locations:

- Healthcare Provider If your healthcare provider is out of the needed vaccine serum, request a
 script to have the pharmacy fill it, then return to the doctor's office to have the doctor's nurse
 administer the shot.

- Urgent Care in your area.
- NO INSURANCE? Call Gloucester County Dept. Health (GCHD) at 856-218-4101 to make an apt. and they will administer vaccinations, FREE of charge.
