



## Immunization Requirements

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Under the NJ State law, N.J.A.C. 8:57-4 students are mandated to have immunizations to keep them and their classmates healthy and to prevent a communicable disease outbreak.

Below is the list of required immunizations for all students. Please look at your child's immunization record and cross-reference it with this list. If you notice any on this list that are not on your child's record, **DO NOT DELAY**, contact your child's Healthcare Provider or the Gloucester County Health Department @ 218-4100 and make an appointment to have the vaccines done free of charge at their Immunization Clinic, then submit documentation to the school, promptly. Thank you.

### Pre-school:

- 4 doses DTP/DTap
- 3 doses Polio
- 1 dose Varicella
- 1 dose PCV
- 1 dose Influenza

### Kindergarten/First Grade:

- 4 doses DTP/DTap
- 3 doses Polio
- 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR (total 2 doses for Kindergarten entry)
- 3 doses Hepatitis B
- 1 dose Varicella

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade (11-year-old shots):

- Tdap
- Meningococcal

\*The school may be subject to fine, and your **child may be excluded from school if this information remains incomplete**. Thank you for your assistance and cooperation in helping to keep all students safe and healthy.
