

Inspira Health has offered to assist with the COVID vaccination of students, staff and the general public at Clayton High School. **COVID Vaccinations will be available on site at Clayton High School Performing Arts Center on Friday, May 7th.**

if you are interested in having your child take advantage of the opportunity to receive the first dose of Pfizer's COVID19 vaccine on campus at the high school on Friday, May 7th. Staff and students will be vaccinated during the school day (8am-12pm). **Inspira is also offering to provide a community event for the general public accepting walk ups to get vaccinated at the school in the afternoon (after students are dismissed) from 1PM-5PM.**

Those interested in obtaining the vaccine must register in advance and complete either the electronic consent embedded in the registration link below (for those 18 years of age and older) complete the minor consent form for those under the age of 18 years. The paper consent must be completed and brought to the vaccination appointment. Additionally you will find the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) Patient Fact Sheet which must be provided to all parents who are giving consent to vaccinate minors. We will also provide a paper hard copy of the EUA fact sheet on site to all those who are vaccinated.

Those interested in being vaccinated should complete the registration information by clicking the link below. All information collected in the registration process is captured securely and communicated directly to Inspira Health. Once registered, representatives from the high school will coordinate the scheduling of students and staff for vaccination on Friday, May 7th. Please register using the link below:

Those electing to be vaccinated will be scheduled for their second dose 3 weeks after their first (May 28th). Second doses will be scheduled when you arrive for your initial dose and will be conducted on site at the High School. While the vaccination process itself takes minutes to complete, please expect to wait 15 minutes after your vaccination for your safety to monitor for any side effects. Those who have a history of allergic reactions for which they carry an EpiPen will be monitored for 30 minutes.
