Our School-wide Expectations Framework Defined

BE RESPONSIBLE – Owning your words and actions and accepting the consequences of your decisions; including stopping to think before you act.

Examples:	Non examples:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Being quiet during appropriate times during class○ Doing homework and classwork on time○ Owning up to your mistakes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Talking during inappropriate times in class○ Avoiding homework and classwork or “making excuses” for incomplete work○ Blaming others for your mistakes

BE RESPECTFUL - Showing consideration for others’ point of view and how your words and actions will affect others.

Examples:	Non examples:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Listening to others○ Being polite even when you disagree with someone○ Apologize if your words or actions accidentally hurt someone	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Interrupting when people are talking○ Being mean to someone with a “different point of view”○ Being “unapologetic” for your words and actions

HAVE INTEGRITY – Knowing the difference between right and wrong, “doing the right thing” whether or not anyone is watching.

Examples:	Non examples:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Telling someone they lost their personal possession○ Making truthful statements that are not hurtful in nature○ Getting help for someone being bullied	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Taking things that don’t belong to you○ Trying to hurt someone by lying or “talking behind their back”○ Ignoring bullying
